Mobile Phone Permission Form

We recognise that parents may sometimes, for safety reasons, wish for their son/daughter to bring a mobile phone into school.

Phones must not be brought into school until the child's class teacher has a completed, signed, form.

- Failure to observe these rules could result in my parent/carer having to collect the phone in person from school and it may also result in me not being allowed to bring my phone into school again
